



Thank you very much for donating a piece to the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Banners which will be added to the TWG permanent collection. We need some information from you so please complete the items listed at the bottom AND attach this to your piece.

Here are a few parameters to help you decide which wonderful small piece to donate!

- Flat weaves: 8-to-9-inch square to allow space for final finishing
- Loose weaves: 9-inch square zig zagged, if possible, to allow space for final finishing
- Bulky weaves: 8-to-9-inch square for 3/2 Double weave, Rep weave, deflected double weave to allow space for final finishing
- Tapestry: 8 inch maximum with 4 inch minimum and finished on all sides. If the tapestry is not square, please stay within this sizing
- All other techniques including surface design and Shibori: contact Janet Borel for sizing, etc. If you are in a study group for one of these techniques, Janet is working with your coordinator.
- Weaving Donation Idea: Add enough warp to your next 8-to-9-inch project.
- Note: To include as many members as possible we are starting by asking for one donated piece per member.
