COVID-19 Guidelines for In-Person Activities
February 1, 2022

These guidelines have been developed by the Triangle Weavers Guild board after careful consideration. They are subject to revision as conditions and government mandates change. We thank you for your cooperation.

While we hope to keep members and non-members safe, the Triangle Weavers Guild cannot guarantee that visitors will not contract Covid-19 while attending guild activities. Members and guests voluntarily assume all risks related to Covid-19.

General guidelines for All Activities at the Triangle Fiber Arts Center (TFAC)

- Anyone entering the Triangle Fiber Arts Center for any TWG event must wear an approved N95 or KN95 mask. An exhaustive list of approved masks is available at [CDC](#).
- Anyone entering TFAC must sign into the sign-in book and provide contact information.
- If anyone has tested positive for Covid-19, been symptomatic of Covid-19, or been exposed to Covid-19 within 10 days of an activity, they are asked not to attend any activity at TFAC.

For In-person Classes, Workshops, and Illuminations

- Participants are required to be vaccinated and boosted (when eligible for booster). TWG will require proof of vaccination (and booster).
 - For members, access the TWG website to submit vaccination information (STW to insert link)
 - For non-members, the information will be collected at registration
- All participants must wear an approved N95 or KN95 mask. If they choose not to wear an N95 or KN95 mask, they must withdraw. A full refund will be offered on withdrawal.
- If any participant has tested positive for Covid-19, been symptomatic of Covid-19, or been exposed to Covid-19 within 10 days of the class or workshop for which they have registered, they must withdraw. A full refund will be offered on withdrawal.
- Participants must sign into the sign-in book and provide contact information.

For Study Group, Drop-in Participants, Volunteers, and Visitors

- All participants in activities at the Triangle Fiber Arts Center must wear an approved N95 or KN95 mask. If they choose not to wear an N95 or KN95 mask, they must not enter.
- All participants must sign into the sign-in book and provide contact information.
- Study groups may decide on other requirements for meetings at TFAC.

Background for these guidelines

These guidelines replace those published on June 21, 2021.

The TWG is committed to providing everyone with a respectful experience of learning and sharing in a safe environment. We will do this in a manner that makes the safety and well-being of members, guests, and visitors our highest priority.

In preparing these guidelines, we have consulted sources at the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS). We have participated in national webinars about reopening arts organizations and have consulted other organizations having similar or related missions (e.g., the John C. Campbell Folk School).

We expect our understanding of what is safe to be revised as researchers learn more about the virus and its mutations. We will continue to revise these guidelines at the discretion of the TWG Board of Directors. We will post updates on the TWG website and make reasonable efforts to notify members of any changes prior to events and activities, including in-person meetings, classes and workshops, drop-ins, and study group meetings at the Triangle Fiber Arts Center (TFAC).

We ask you to remain mindful and aware as we reopen in-person activities. A set of guidelines such as these will not anticipate every instance requiring a stricter or more relaxed level of protection. We ask that you also use your common sense and place the health and safety of all members of the community first.

The TWG cannot guarantee that anyone will not contract COVID-19 while on the TFAC premises or at off-site, in-person events and activities sponsored by TWG. By registering for an in-person class or workshop, attending a program, visiting the TFAC, or volunteering at outreach activities, members and guests voluntarily assume all risks related to COVID-19.
